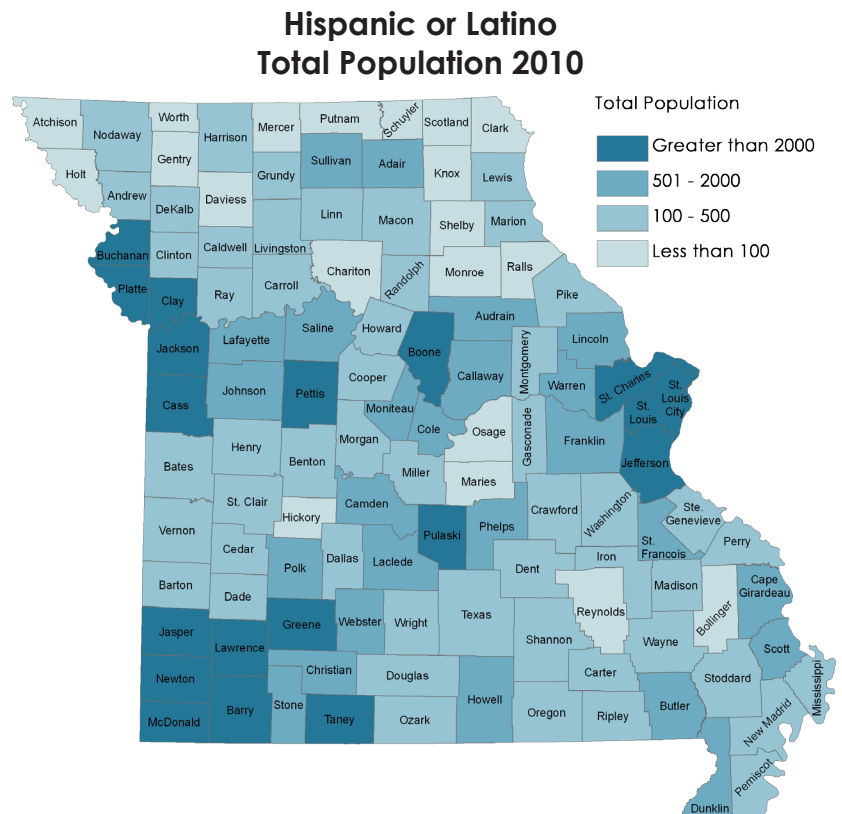
## Hispanic or Latino Origin

### 2010 Census

The 2010 Decennial Census publishes regional population demographics for ethnicity, race and age groups. This profile will feature county trends and statistics for Missouri's population of *Hispanic or Latino Origin*.

Missouri's population of *Hispanic or Latino Origin* grew by a striking 79 percent from 118,592 in 2000 to 212,470 in 2010, down from the 92 percent growth of the previous decade. In contrast, Missouri's total population grew by 9.3 percent from slightly under 5.6 million in 2000 to over 5.9 million in 2010.

Thirty Missouri counties more than doubled their Hispanic population between 2000 and 2010. Jackson (21,270) and St. Louis County (10,447) each saw a net increase of over 10,000 people of *Hispanic or Latino Origin*.

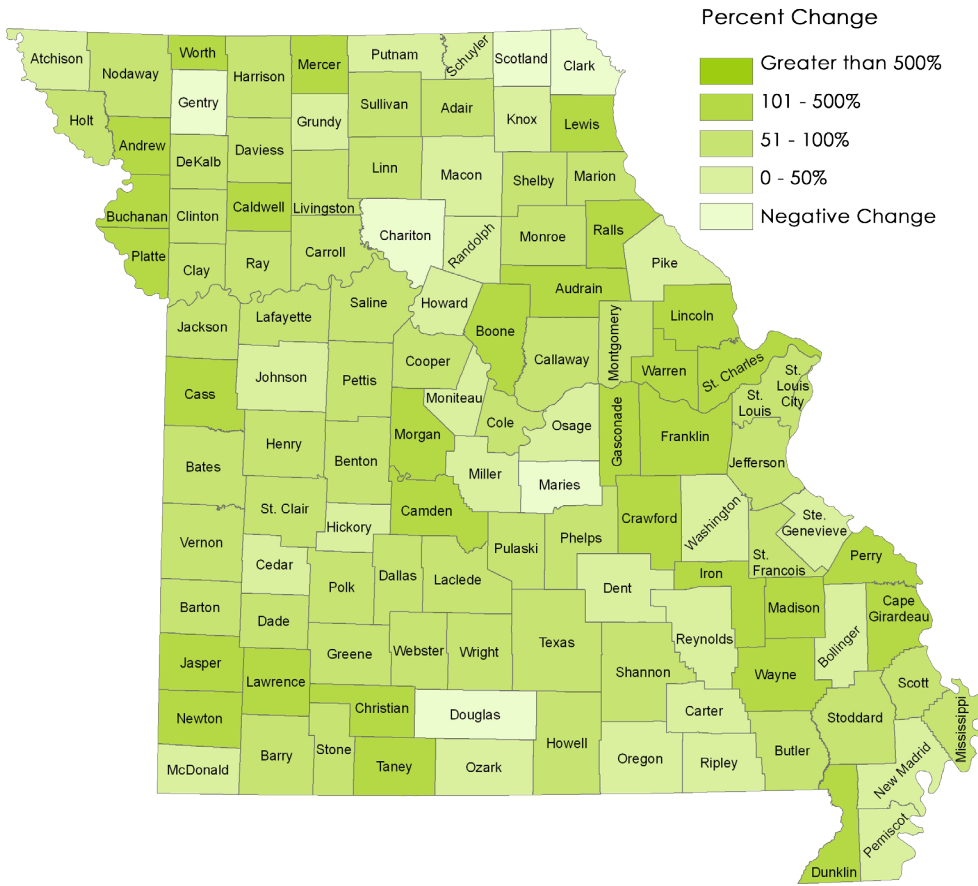


### Population Growth

Madison (270%), Audrain (255%), Perry (242%), Worth (229%), and Warren (205%) counties each saw over 200 percent growth in their people of *Hispanic or Latino Origin* since 2000.

Not all of Missouri counties experienced positive growth in Hispanic populations. Maries County experienced the largest percent decline (-27%) in its Hispanic population compared to seeing a 3 percent growth of its total population. Scotland, Clark, Gentry and Chariton counties each reported double-digit percent decline in persons of *Hispanic or Latino Origin* compared to single digit percent decline of the total population.

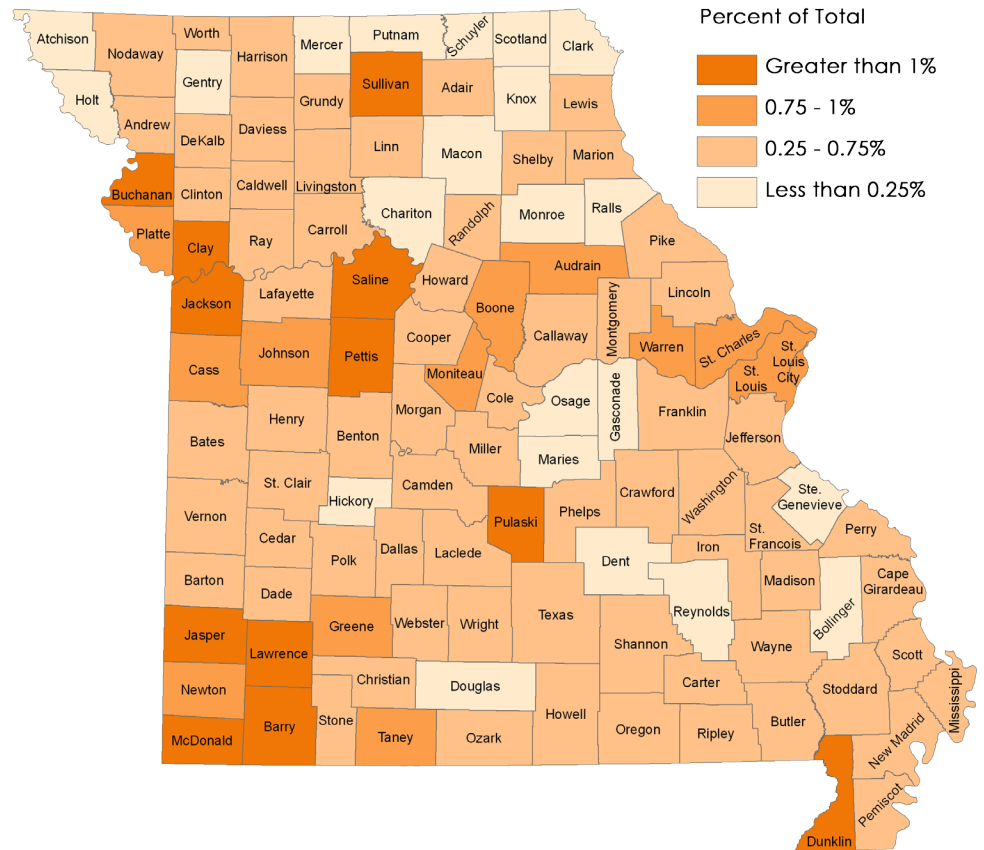

### Population Share

Missouri's population of *Hispanic or Latino Origin* has more than tripled since 1990, and accounts for a growing percentage (3.5) of the state's population compared to 2.1 percent of the 2000 population count. Seventeen counties exceed the state's concentration. Sullivan County, with 18.5 percent of its total population being of *Hispanic or Latino Origin* is the only Missouri county to exceed the United States concentration of 16.3 percent. McDonald County, with 11.2 percent, is the only other county to exceed 10 percent of its total 2010 population being from *Hispanic or Latino Origin*.
