## **Central Region Top Openings**

The Central region is expected to have more than 90,000 total job openings between 2014 and 2024. This includes openings created by new job growth, as well as those created through the need for replacement workers. Replacement openings occur due to retirement, turnover, or transferring to another occupation.

During this projection period, the 20 occupations with the greatest number of total openings includes 4 Office and Administrative Support Occupations and 4 Food Preparation and Serving Occupations. "Cashiers" and "Retail Salespersons", both Sales occupations, are expected to have the most total openings during the projection period, with over 4,000 total openings for each occupation.
