Southeast Region Top Openings

The Southeast region is expected to have over 40,000 total job openings between 2014 and 2024. This includes openings created by new job growth, as well as those created through the need for replacement workers. Replacement openings occur due to retirement, turnover, or transferring to another occupation.

During this projection period, the 20 occupations with the greatest number of total openings includes 4 Office and Administrative Support Occupations and 3 Sales Occupations. "Cashiers" and "Personal Care Aides" are the occupations that are expected to have the most total openings between 2014 and 2024, with over 2,000 total openings expected for each occupation.
